

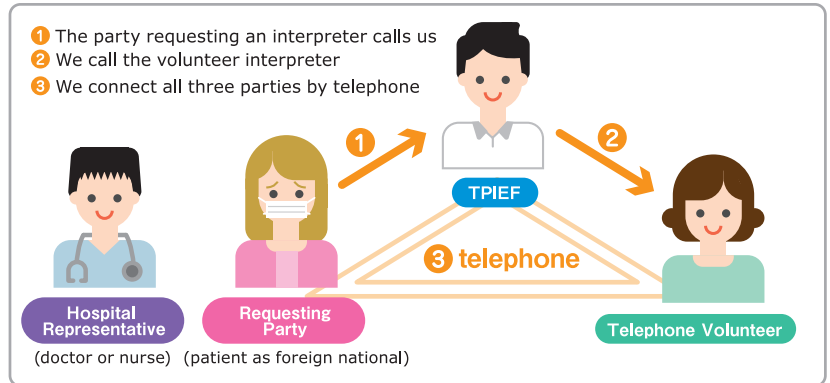

## Dispatch of Specialized Volunteer Interpreters

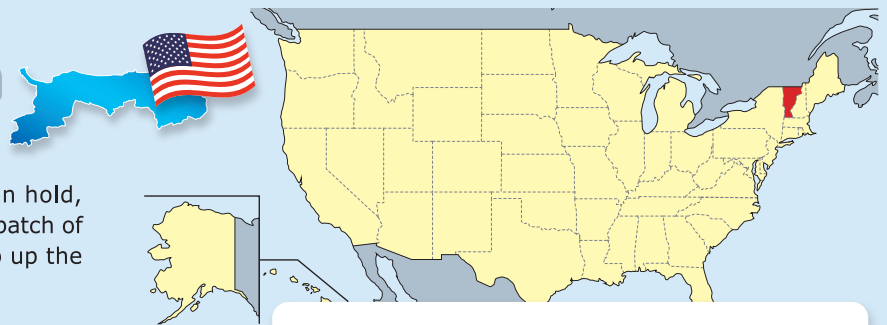
Interpreter dispatch is currently suspended (as of June 2020)

The national census is taken every five years in the middle of September. (Responses are collected until 7 October.)

**The census is for all persons and households with residence in Japan. Foreign residents are also expected to respond.** Responding online is particularly convenient. Census data is invaluable in determining national policy for the future, and is one of the fundamental resources for measures that make the country a better place for foreign nationals to live as well.
